Rules and Regulations

The following Rules and Regulations are published by **Adrienne Gamboa and Greg Ford** owners of **Elite Sporthorse**, and issued to all boarders, riders, families and their guests. These Rules and Regulations are published for the purpose of maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all horses, boarders, riders and their guests. Violations of these rules may result in termination of the boarding agreement.

BARN HOURS

Monday	8:00 AM until 9:00 PM
Tuesday thru Friday	1:00 PM until 9:00 PM
Saturday and Sunday	7:00 AM until 7:00 PM
Major Holidays	7:00 AM until 1:00 PM

Please notify barn personnel if you would like to arrive before opening hours.

RIDING AND TRAINING

We maintain excellent facilities for riding and training our horses—with premium footing in our indoor and outdoor arenas, a riding trail around the property and a dedicated lunging circle. The following rules help us ensure a safe environment for both horses and riders:

- Elite Sporthorse encourages all riders to wear helmets and requires all riders under the age of 21 to wear approved safety helmets at all times while mounted on a horse
- While working with your horse, please be respectful of other riders, lessons and/or training sessions
- To help us maintain our schedule, please be prompt for all lessons—we will not be able to extend your lesson time if you are late
- Please do not use the outdoor arena or riding trail during rainfall or when the footing is wet
- Please only walk, and do not trot or canter, on the riding trail
- Riding in the grass arena is only permitted during lessons
- Lunging is only permitted in the lunging circle

- If you use the lights in the indoor arena, please turn off the lights and close the electric box when you are finished
 - Please do not move jumps, cavalettis or poles
 - Jumping is only permitted with trainer supervision
 - Guests may not ride without prior consent of Elite Sporthorse, and then only after the guest signs and gives Elite Sporthorse a release of liability form

FACILITIES AND GENERAL CARE

The following rules apply to the grounds and facilities at Elite Sporthorse:

- Due to the stallions on the premises, horses must be kept out of proximity of the trainer barn—no walking horses through the aisle or close to the trainer barn
- Grazing is permitted in designated areas during dry conditions
- No outside dogs are allowed on the property
- Please do not run car engines or honk horns in the parking lot
- Please help us keep the restroom clean and wipe feet before entering, and lock the door and turn off the lights when you are finished
- Clients may lease a space to park their trailer on Elite Sporthorse property, please see the Rates and Fees sheet for lease terms

Barns

Please help us keep the barns and tack rooms clean, tidy and safe by following these rules:

- Clean up after yourself—including picking up manure from the aisle, wash rack, walkways and putting tack and supplies away
- Horses may not be left unattended in the aisles or crossties, other than to walk to the tackroom for equipment or supplies
- Please turn off all lights when you have finished and close the tack room doors
- One (1) trunk per horse is permitted in front of each stall
- Our personnel cleans each stall twice daily, boarders are not permitted to clean the stalls themselves and self-service of shavings is not allowed
- Tack may be stored in the tack room on designated saddleracks and bridle hooks (Elite Sporthorse is not responsible for damaged, moldy or lost tack)
- No unauthorized borrowing of tack or supplies belonging to Elite Sport horse or other boarders
- No unauthorized entry into the trainers' barn, worksheds, tack rooms, laundry room, or vet clinic
- All children under 14 must be supervised by an adult at all times while on the property
- No one under the age of 21 is allowed to operate or sit on any equipment on the property including tractor, lawn mower, Kubota etc.
- Hang up the hoses at the wash rack and make sure the water is turned off when finished

Pastures and Hotwalker

Weather permitting, all horses at Elite Sporthorse enjoy daily turnout in private pastures. During rainfall, or when the ground is too wet, horses receive sessions on the hotwalker as an alternative. The following rules apply to our pastures and hotwalker:

- Barn personnel will turn out horses and and/or put them on the hotwalker, boarders are not permitted to turn horses out or put them on the hotwalker

Feed and Supplements

Elite Sporthorse uses premium feeds and hay, and works with clients to customize each horse's diet based on exercise and conditioning. The following rules help us ensure that each horse receives the nutrition required to perform at their best:

- Horses are fed by barn personnel three times per day, boarders are not permitted to feed horses themselves and self-service of feed or hay is not allowed
- Additional feed and/or supplements will be given by barn personnel, and must be bagged and stored at the front of the stall

ROUTINE VETERINARY AND FARRIER SERVICES

Elite Sporthorse works with top veterinarians and trainers to maintain the health and soundness of each horse on the premises. The following rules apply to routine services, please discuss emergency and/or additional services directly with Adrienne Gamboa:

- Elite Sporthorse deworms all horses every other month
- Routine veterinary service—including vaccinations, teeth floating and Coggins tests—is performed by the farm vet
- All horses must have a current negative Coggins certificate
- Elite Sporthorse provides regular service from a top farrier, and clients are encouraged to utilize his services
- If clients choose to use an alternate farrier, they must make independent arrangements

SHOW PREPARATION AND RULES

Elite Sporthorse attends shows locally and throughout Texas and the surrounding region. To help us be organized and well-prepared, clients are asked to follow these rules in preparation for all shows:

- Entry forms and deposits must be made within the designated timetable
- All clients must furnish a clear, plastic trunk and pack bridle, girth, pads, boots and other show tack for each horse
- The trunks must be packed and placed in front of the horse's stalls prior to show departure
- Saddles must be packed into the trailer prior to show departure
- Unless other arrangements are made and communicated to Show Elite Sport horse, we will prepare the horse (pulling mane and clipping feet, muzzle, etc.) prior to the horse show and will bill the boarder according to the fee's set in the rate schedule
